

## ETWHA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The East Tennessee Walking Horse Association will award one (1) scholarship of \$1,000 based on academic performance, extra-curricular activities, and equine activities. The scholarship recipient is eligible to use the award for expenses at the college, university, community college or trade school of his or her choice.

- Applicant must be entering a college, university, community college or trade school for the first time and under the age of 25.
- Applicant cannot apply for the scholarship before his or her junior year of high school.
- Applicant must have a parent or grandparent who is a member of the East Tennessee Walking Horse Association (ETWHA) in good standing for at least 16 months prior to their scholarship application.
- Applicant must have a high school or college GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicant must have an ACT score of 20 or higher or an SAT score of 1020 or higher.
- Application and attached copies must be received by **July 31** to be evaluated for award of scholarship.
- The following copies must be included with the application: proof of ACT or SAT scores, official copy of current high school transcript, and letter of acceptance from college, university, community college or trade school.
- Submit an essay regarding "How the Tennessee Walking Horse has influenced my life."

## **SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

The East Tennessee Walking Horse Association will award one (1) individual scholarship out of a pool of qualified applicants. The applicant who has met the above qualifications will be awarded \$1,000 for their first semester of college. Only one (1) scholarship per individual will awarded.
