Rule Clarifications:

- 1) **Racking vs Walking**- A Horse may show in EITHER walking or racking classes at this show, but not both.
- 2) A **Spotted Horse** may cross enter into EITHER Walking or Racking Classes at this show, but not both.
- 3) **Walking Cross Entering**-Horses may not cross enter at this show between All Day Walking (3/8 x 3/4 shoe), Trail Walking (3/8 x 3/4 shoe), and Country Walking (3/8 x 1 shoe).
- 4) **"Walking Pleasure" classes**-These are combined classes. Horses may cross enter into these class so long as other rules listed herein are not violated.
- 5) **Registration Requirements**-Spotted Horses do not have to be registered spotted. Country Pleasure Walking do not have to be registered Walking. And Racking Horses do not have to be registered racking.
- 6) **All Day Pleasure Racking**-3/8 x 3/4 max shoe.
- 7) **Go As You Please Classes**-Open to any flat shod horse regardless of what other division it may have shown in. Gaits called will be "Walk" and "Favorite Gait". Judged on best overall presentation of the horse, regardless of that horse's normal division. Specific qualities associated with a particular discipline should be neither rewarded nor penalized in this class.
- 8) **Easy Gait Classes**-3/8 x 3/4 max shoe. Gaits will be called as "Walk" and "Easy Gait". Walk should be a true walk and easy gait should be a slow, comfortable gait. Judged on rider to mount suitability, ability of horse to work comfortably on a loose rein, neatness of appearance and overall presentation, and behavior of the horse in the ring. Mistakes should be penalized in judging.
- 9) These rules supersede the rules of any HIO or other association rules at this show.
